Carl E. Falco was born in Camden, New Jersey on March 28, 1951. He attended Claremont Men's College in Claremont, California and North Carolina State University in Raleigh, North Carolina. Carl earned a Bachelors degree in both Forestry and Entomology in 1976.

In 1976, Carl became a structural pest control inspector for North Carolina and was promoted to field supervisor in 1981. He became Assistant Director of the Structural Pest Control Division in 1990 and director in 1996 until he retired June 1, 2006, after thirty years of service.

During his service to North Carolina, Carl served as Chairman of Region 4 Issues and Research and Evaluation Group; was a member of the Termiticide Label Workgroup; ASPCRO chairman of ASPCRO/EPA Termiticide Bait Efficacy workgroup and a member of North Carolina's Pesticide Board, appointed by Governor James Hunt. During his service to ASPCRO, he served as Secretary/Treasurer, Vice President and was President from 1997 to 1999.

The positive impact Carl has had on the structural pest control industry, the regulatory community, and his contributions to ASPCRO, are greatly appreciated. Carl E. Falco is hereby inducted into the ASPCRO Hall of Fame on this 28th day of August, 2007.
