

James P. Harron started with the Georgia Department of Agriculture in 1978. In 1998, Jim became a member of the Georgia Structural Pest Control Commission, representing the Georgia Department of Agriculture. Jim's formal education includes a B.S.A. in entomology from the University of Georgia...

In 1984, Jim became the Secretary/Treasurer for the Association of Structural Pest Control Regulatory Officials. He served in that capacity through 1985. In 1987 he became ASPCRO's Vice-President and served as President in 1988 and 1989.

In 1991 Jim was nominated to serve on ASPCRO's Executive Committee and has served in that capacity in 1992, 1993, 1994, 2001, 2002. In 1993 he served on the Nomination's Committee, a position he has held several times since. Jim also served on the Registered Technician Committee from 1994 till 1999 and the Structural Training for State Inspectors from 2001 and 2002. In 2005, at the request of ASPCRO, Jim hosted a multi-day training session that included five members of USEPA to discuss and train on label issues.
