



David Earl Scott was born in Lafayette, Indiana on February 14th, 1955. He graduated from Lafayette Jefferson High School and was a starter on their 1973 state championship baseball team. He majored in General Science at Purdue University and graduated with a Bachelors of Science degree in May, 1977.
