

Investigator Training Committee (ITC) Annual Report August 23, 2017

Currently, the Investigator Training Committee (ITC) is working with the Council on Licensure, Enforcement and Regulation (CLEAR) and the PIRT committee to develop a training session to be held in 2018. The goal is to allow states to send inspectors to the PIRT training for a three-day CLEAR Basic program and a fourth day of training in a topic yet to be determined by the PIRT committee. As of this date, the Executive Director of CLEAR has voiced his interest in working with ITC and the PIRT committee and has suggested CLEAR might be interested in collaborating with PIRT for more programs in the future. The details are yet to be worked out but the ultimate goal is to have a mechanism through the PIRTs where inspectors could ultimately achieve full CLEAR certification.
