2011 ASPCRO Conference Board Meeting Report

The ASPCRO Label Language Recommendation Committee, (3C) committee submits the following report for the 2011 conference Board meeting.

The committee activity for the past year continued to be minimal, primarily due to one co-chair retirement and the Board demands of the other.

The committee did have some activity in October 2010 with several emails and a conference call. Members were sent the mission and action statement to review. No comments were received. During the call the committee discussed reviewing both the label review manual and the EPA online label training to see if we could provide any comments to EPA from a structural perspective.

The committee also reviewed proposed changes developed by John Scott to address issues on the phostoxin label. No formal input was provided to EPA, however comments and concerns were discussed directly with EPA staff in the registration division. The changes were also brought before AAPCO POM, who did provide input to EPA as well. A final determination as to acceptance of the changes has not yet been released by the agency.

A call for membership is being made to obtain interest in committee membership in order to continue any needed efforts by the committee. The chair hopes her leisure time as past president will allow renewed dedication to the committee.
