Activities

A Structural Remediation Committee (SRC) session was held August 22, 2016 at the Annual ASPCRO conference in Santa Fe, NM. During the meeting the committee discussed the Structural Remediation Guidance document.

The Committee settled on a document with five main sections: 1) Assess/Evaluate; 2) Determine Action; 3) Remediate; 4) Reassess; 5) Clearance and Closeout.

With emphasis being placed on the “structural” component of remediation, the scope of the guidance document has been adjusted to emphasize providing basic considerations, references, and points of contact rather than making the document itself an exhaustive “how-to” that covers every conceivable situation and scenario.

On March 16, 2017 a rough draft of the guidance document was distributed to the SRC committee members and interested parties for comments and suggestions. Comments received were taken into consideration in subsequent revisions. The final draft is near completion and is intended to be added to the online ASPCRO library.

In July 2017, Irene King stepped down from the Co-Chair role in the Structural Remediation Committee, but she may be able to contribute to the committee when she can. We wish her the best of luck and extend our thanks for her contributions to the committee.

Meeting scheduled:

SRC will meet on Monday, August 28, 2017 at the 61st Annual ASPCRO Conference in Burlington Vermont. The intention of the meeting is to discuss the concept and feasibility of a “living” document to be periodically updated and contributed to.
