State Meeting Assistance Committee

The Association of Structural Pest Control Regulatory Officials (ASPCRO) formed the State Meeting Assistance Committee (SMAC) in 2005. Members of the SMAC consist of ASPCRO members. The primary goal of SMAC is to facilitate training programs such as a “Structural Compliance Assistance Training” in ASPCRO member states. The scope of this committee is to provide assistance to states holding training sessions in cooperation with ASPCRO. The committee will promote SMAC as a resource to SLAs.

- ASPCRO will sponsor four (4) state compliance training meetings.
 - The Office of the Indiana State Chemist will conduct four (4) training sessions in October and November of 2011. The anticipated number of attendees is expected to be 370 participants, with space to expand if necessary. It is estimated that the four programs could generate \$20,000 for ASPCRO.
