State Meeting Assistance Committee

The Association of Structural Pest Control Regulatory Officials (ASPCRO) formed the State Meeting Assistance Committee (SMAC) in 2005. Members of the SMAC consist of ASPCRO members. The primary goal of SMAC is to facilitate training programs such as a “Structural Compliance Assistance Training” in ASPCRO member states. The scope of this committee is to provide assistance to states holding training sessions in cooperation with ASPCRO. The committee will promote SMAC as a resource to SLAs.

- ASPCRO has not sponsored any SMAC programs for the 2012-2013 year. However, Alabama Department of Agriculture and Industries made an inquiry about using SMAC for future trainings. The Delaware Department of Agriculture inquired about using the services of the SMAC Committee to host the 2013 Region 3 State Pesticide Inspectors Workshop.
