LEGISLATIVE PROPOSALS- SB22-131 PROTECT HEALTH OF POLLINATORS AND PEOPLE

- restricts the use of pesticides on the grounds of a school, preschool program, child care center, or children's resident camp
- requires a study on how to address pollinator decline and increase pollinator health in the state
- creates a program to provide grants to test the use of non-coated seeds
- rules designating certain pesticides as restricted-use
- remove certain preemptions regarding local government regulation of pesticide use.

SUNSET REVIEWS

Termination of a
statute/program/governmental
function

If a regulation is
determined to be needed,
the sunset review will look
for the least restrictive
level of regulation
consistent with the public
interest.

WHAT DOES THE LOSS OF PREEMPTION LOOK LIKE?

- EPA Cooperative Agreement (adequate legal authority)
 - How long does it take?
 - What happens if the state is unable to fix until the next general assembly?
 - Freeze grant funds?
 - Wind down the program?
