2. Old Business:

- a. White paper on pesticides and children – A draft white paper was reviewed, and a meeting date selection will be sent via email to SLA committee members to pick a meeting date sometime prior to the midyear meeting.   - c. EPA Grant for outreach – Georgia shared information on grant they received from EPA (region 4) to do outreach to schools. This grant enables GDA to teach students about IPM.
  - d.
