

Sunset Review

- Colorado General Assembly sets specific dates that a particular agency, board, or function of government will terminate unless the legislature passes new legislation to continue.
- In Colorado, a sunset review will generally question the need for regulation to protect the public.
- If regulation is determined to be needed, the sunset review will look for the least restrictive level of regulation consistent with the public interest.

How many roads...

- 2006 Sunset Reenacted for 9 years
- 2015 Sunset Reenacted for 8 years, DORA recommended 9 years
- 2021 Preemption Neonicotinoid legislation
- 2022 Preemption Neonicotinoid legislation
- 2023 Sunset Reenacted for 9 years Neonicotinoid





2021 - 2022

- 2021 Covid ended the legislative session early
- 2022 11 hours of testimony to defeat the bill





2023 Sunset Review

- 2023 PAA reenacted for 9 years
 - Industry survey results
 - 96% favorable Service provided by the program
 - 96% favorable Program's communication and usefulness
 - 97% favorable Program listened to customer concerns
 - 96% favorable Timeliness of response to concerns
 - 97% favorable Helpfulness of the program resolving issues
 - 99% favorable Professionalism of the program staff
 - 98% favorable Accuracy of information provided



2023 Sunset Legislation

- 2023 PAA reenacted for 9 years
 - Preemption
 - Didn't have the votes in the House Ag Committee
 - Introduced in the Senate Transportation and Energy Committee hearing on Environmental Standards for Appliances
 - "I'm trying to figure out how adopting regulations limiting the use of pesticides fits under the environmental standards for certain products, what's the product change?"
 - Bill sponsor, "this title is certain "products" and pesticides are certainly a product."

2023 Legislative Session

- 2023 Pesticide Act legislation
 - Neonicotinoids designated as a limited-use pesticide
 - Dealer license required to sell, no licensure, no records, exemptions for certain products
