

The Association of Structural Pest Control Regulatory Officials (ASPCRO) is excited to open nominations for the Fourth Annual Inspector Training! The training will be held in-person on Tuesday August 20th at the Hilton Lexington Downtown Hotel in Lexington, KY as part of the 2024 ASPCRO Annual Conference. State, tribal and territory ASPCRO members can nominate a member of their inspection/investigation teams for the training. Training topics will focus on inspectors having experience enforcing pesticide laws and regulations.

This year's training will feature 9 short topics featuring state regulatory officials and industry members and a case study to round out the training.

There is no cost for the training and all attendees will receive free registration to attend the general sessions during the 2024 ASPCRO Annual Conference.
