

ITC 2026 Midyear Report

1. 17 members in initial cohort.
2. Following announcement opening up ITC webinars to dues-paying ASPCRO members, we increased to approx. 35 inspectors attending the Webinar series.
3. Only 3 more Webinars until we meet in August for the in-person practical.
4. **In-person practical agenda** – finalized as much as possible and have been working with Brad Baker for his input. Brad secured the in-person practical site: Switchback Stadium, a MLS stadium. The 3 scenarios will include: loading dock/exterior of building, concessions, and locker room.
5. Ed Messina will be providing some welcome remarks to the cohort along with Dave Huber and John Pitcock. Every year at the in-person practical, the ITC wants to invite a high-ranking EPA employee to bring a unique perspective to new inspectors.
6. **Accreditation** –
 1. need to have a list of names of graduates on the webpage, explain on the ITC page what the ITC Webinar Series provides, and then branding will follow.
 2. Make similar to [NCPMA | Premier Technician](#) page.
 3. Create new logo that incorporates the ASPCRO logo with a “badge” that reads “Inspector Training Committee Accreditation” (see attached for rough draft)
 4. Create a binder with tabs for each presentation and ship to each cohort member at the onset of the next year’s training. Shipping funds will be a sponsorship.
 5. Potentially have votes from the ITC Committee that would result in travel being paid by ASPCRO (through sponsorships). Votes would be had for “most engaged inspector”, etc.
7. New Webinar to be presented by the ITC Committee for next year’s series re: “Do you know your own rules?” where we discuss the most questioned parts of our States’ rules/regulations/statutes.
