

Robert M. Rosenberg received a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration in 1974 from the University of Florida; a Master of Science Degree in Government from Florida State University in 1977 and a Master of Arts Degree in Political Science from the University of Chicago in 1980. That same year, Bob began his government service in the state of Florida with the Department of Business Regulation, Division of Para-Mutual Wagering, ultimately becoming Director in 1984.

In 1989 Bob took a position as Manager of State Government Affairs with the National Pest Management Association (NPMA). He became Director of Government Affairs in 1981 and Vice-President of Government Affairs in 2003. In 2013 Bob was elevated to his current position as Executive Vice President of NPMA.

During his tenure with NPMA, Bob has worked diligently with ASPCRO, providing support to the Board and membership to help promote reasonable regulation for the pest control industry. From the beginning, Bob played a major role in addressing key topics and issues, the first of which was local ordinance and state pesticide law primacy in 1990. Other issues have included tackling ramifications of the proposed Chemical Application Bill of 1991, development and implementation of PR Notice 96-7 for termiticide labeling, garnering industry and regulatory support for continued funding of the Gulfport Research Station by the US Forest Service, addressing the new technology of termite bait and baiting systems including ASPCRO's model rule development, stating with finesse it was an 'unnecessary and flawed document', and most recently successfully participating in coordination of the pest management industry, EPA and ASPCRO to improve label language for rodenticides and pyrethroid products.

Bob consistently has benefited the Association in his tireless support of the annual conference from contributing to agenda development, his participation in presentations and panel sessions, and gathering support for meeting sponsorship.

The positive impact Bob has had on the structural pest control industry and the regulatory community and his contributions to ASPCRO are greatly appreciated. Robert M. Rosenberg is hereby inducted into the ASPCRO Hall of Fame on this 20th day of August 2013.
